
1. I sing the might-y power of God That made the moun-tains rise;

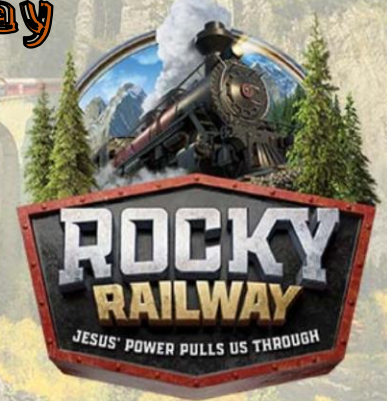
